KEN DELANEY ((cer)

For this production Ken takes the dual role of Producer and the character Gooper. Some would suspect that the former role was to ensure the latter. What's more, as further insurance of his role in the show, Ken also serves as President of CCT. "Cat" marks his eighth show with the group, including one show as director. In his spare time Ken works for WTVB/WNWN radio.

LISA McFARLAND (Margaret)

This is Lisa's second show with CCT. She appeared in the chorus of "The Unsinkable Molly Brown." She is employed as an accountant with Caroline Lowe, CPA and Putnam Manufacturing. In her spare time, Lisa enjoys dance classes.

DAN ROWLEY (Brick)

A former all-state football player from Hudson, Michigan, this is Dan's first production with CCT. He has lived in Coldwater 14 months and is employed at the Florence Crane Women's Facility.

JAYNE LILLIS (Mae)

Jayne is a veteran of several CCT productions. She has appeared as a hot box girl in "Guys and Dolls," Elaine in "Last of the Red Hot Lovers," and most recently as Princess DeLong in "The Unsinkable Molly Brown." A former Spanish teacher, Jayne is currently an at-home-mom to daughter, Bethany.

GEORGIANNA HOLCOMB (Big Mama)

This is Georgianna's second dramatic role with CCT. Besides appearing on stage the past two years with the group, Georgianna has designed sets, handled props, and taken a few strokes with a paint brush. She says these backstage experiences make her appreciate what it takes to make any production work.

LANCE HOUCK (Big Daddy)

In only a few short years with CCT, Lance has accumulated an impressive list of credits, including the Judge in "Harvey," Rats Branigan in "Big Al Goes Straight," and Dowdy in "Mister Roberts." A former Coldwater School Board Member, Lance is employed at the Florence Crane Women's Facility.

RICK LLOYD (Dr. Baugh)

Rick returns to the stage this fall after enjoying his role in "Mister Roberts" last year. Rick performs as Executive Director of Big Brothers/Big Sisters in his other life. He has brought a daughter, Becky, to the stage and has another aspiring actress at home.

BILL SHOOP (Rev. Tooker)

Truly a veteran of CCT, Bill has been involved since its revival in 1979. He has taken part in all aspects of production -- set design, light design, directing, and of course, acting. His last roles on stage were a preacher in "Big Al Goes Straight," and as the assassin in "It Was A Dark and Stormy Night." During CCT's last season, Bill also directed "Mister Roberts." He is the owner of Woodcrafters in Sherwood.

LINDA WOLFE

This is Linda's second appearance on the Tibbits stage. She had a role in the Tibbits Young Audiences production of "Robin Hood." Linda says she has lots of dogs and loves birds.

AUTUMN HARTFORD

Autumn is nine years old and attends 4th grade at Jefferson Elementary. She began her performing career early by taking 2nd place in a beauty pageant when she was five. Autumn has also been in previous CCT Christmas productions.

MAT BORTON

Mat joins CCT for his first production, although he has performed in school plays. Mat is a sixth grader at Legg School.

BECKY LLOYD

Nine-year-old Becky is making her fourth stage appearance. Her first role was in Tibbits Summer Theatre's "South Pacific" when she was six. She also appeared in the Young Audiences productions of "Hey George" and "Robin Hood."

BEN NEWELL

Ten-year-old Ben is a 5th grader at Lakeland Elementary in Coldwater. While this is his first appearance with CCT, he has performed with his schoolmates in a state play competition called "Odyssey of the Mind." Their original production took Fifth place.

MIKE PETREY (Director)

Mike brings to CCT a wealth of experience. Originally from New Orleans, he has worked in community and professional theater for the past 15 years, including directing "A Streetcar Named Desire," "Wizard of Oz," "Of Mice and Men" and "Indian Wants The Bronx." Mike is currently the Technical Director of the Tibbits Opera House.

CHRISTINE DELANEY (Stage Manager)
