

RICK LLOYD (Chief Johnson) is new to CCT, taking the stage for the first time since high school in 1967. Offstage, Rick is the Director of the Big Brothers/Big Sisters and the father of one son, Craig, 13, and two daughters, Karen, 11 and Becky, 8. All of his children have stage experience.

RICK DUNCAN (Mister Roberts) considers himself very lucky to get to play Elwood in "Harvey", Nathan Detroit in "Guys & Dolls" and to top it off, Mr. Roberts, and all within a year. Rick has been having a great time working with everyone in CCT. He looks forward to telling his grand-children tall tales about being a star once upon a time in the big city.

CHUCK LILLIS (Doc) is appearing in his first CCT production. Chuck has previously appeared in productions of "Alas, Babylon", "The Odd Couple", "Mr. Roberts", "St. Joan", and an original production "Whatever Happened to Dr. O'Kosh?". In his spare time he is working on an interior design degree to accompany his Associate Degree in architectural engineering.

KURT PIFER (Ensign Pulver) is pleased to have the chance to perform once again with CCT. He previously performed with CCT in "Little Mary Sunshine" and "Folley's Quarter". He has also appeared in various Tibbits summer stock productions along with the ETC Company at Jackson Community College.
